**Serif fonts** like Georgia and Times have “feet” coming out from the ends of vertical strokes. These feet are the serifs.

*Pronunciation:*  
‘Serif’ rhymes with  
‘sheriff’.

**Sans serif fonts** like Myriad Pro do not have these feet. “Sans” is a French word for “without” so it literally means “without serif”. Though they are associated with modern typography, sans serif fonts date from the 1810s.

*Pronunciation:*  
‘Sans’ rhymes with  
‘hands’.
